

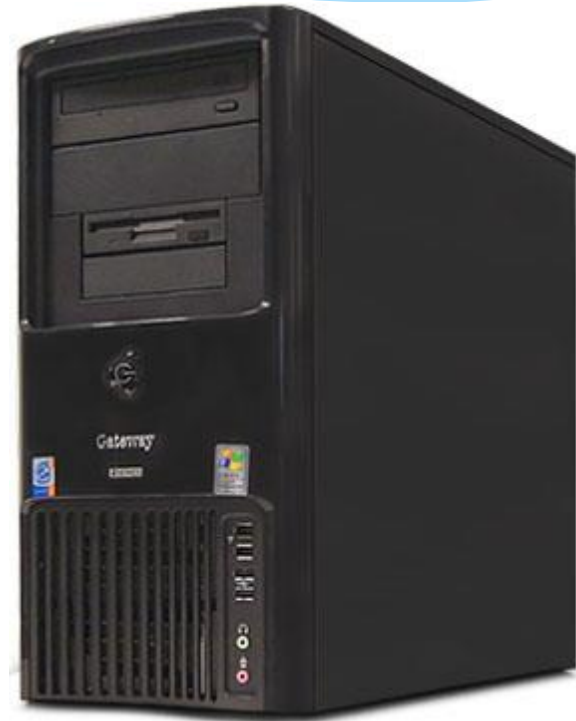
Basic Computer Terms

The Tower

- This is the computer tower. It houses all of the components that make the computer work properly.
- Unless you have extensive knowledge of computer repair, you should not attempt to fix anything inside there, and you should never attempt to repair the library's computers.



The Monitor

- The monitor displays visual information about what the computer is doing.
- On the monitor you can see various things to interact with, such as icons and the taskbar.



The Headphones

- When at the library, you can use these headphones to listen to sounds the computer makes, including alert sounds and anything you are having the computer play, such as games or music.



The Mouse

- This is a mouse.
- The mouse is used to control the cursor (or pointer) that appears on your screen.
- With cursor you can interact with things you see on your monitor.



The Keyboard

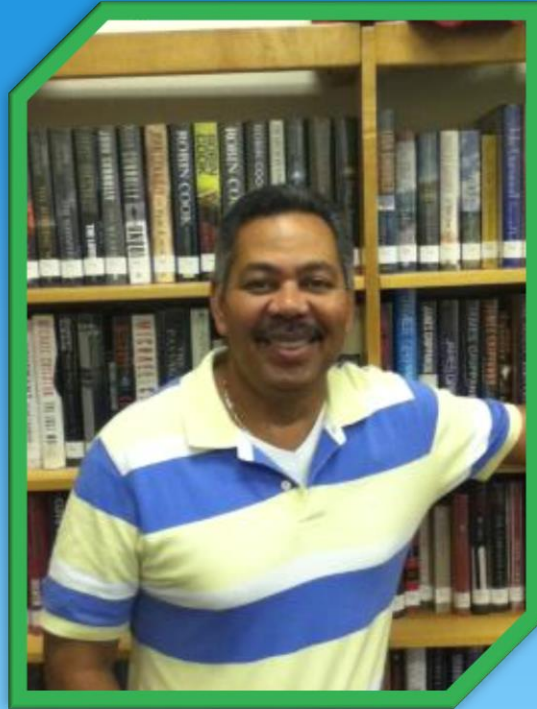
- This is a keyboard.
